Scope of Position

Ambassadors represent Make-A-Wish Southern Nevada at various community events to share information regarding our National and local history, our mission, how to refer a child, and how the audience can get involved with our chapter. Ambassadors may be invited to speak with service organizations, corporations, and schools and will know in advance what is required for each presentation. As an Ambassador of Make-A-Wish Southern Nevada, you will educate audiences on the healing power of a wish!

Key Responsibilities

- ★ Obtain Booth-in-a-Box materials, if necessary, from Make-A-Wish office prior to speaking engagement or event. Responsible for returning materials afterward
- ★ Set up outreach booth at speaking engagement or event, if needed
- ★ Distribute Make-A-Wish information and marketing collateral
- ★ Answer questions regarding volunteer opportunities, the wish process and events
- ★ Act as a Make-A-Wish liaison to represent the Southern Nevada Chapter in a professional manner
- ★ Deliver enthusiastic presentations that highlight our mission, vision and values. Presentation to be tailored to each organization

Qualifications

- ★ Knowledge of Make-A-Wish mission, vision, values and standards
- ★ Strong communication and public speaking skills
- ★ Excellent customer service skills, friendly and polite
- ★ Reliable transportation & ability to lift up to 20lbs
- ★ Public speaking experience

Time Commitment

- ★ 2-5 hour time commitment, depending on event needs and outreach opportunity

Location

- ★ The majority of ambassador opportunities will be located off-site, within Southern Nevada territory
- ★ Opportunities could take place at the Make-A-Wish Southern Nevada office
